## Garing to Present at American Alliance of Museums Webinar

### *Mueller Vice President to Address Air Filtration in HVAC Design*

Todd Garing, PE, LEED AP BD+C, vice president of Mueller Associates, will address air filtration in HVAC system design in a webinar entitled “Navigating the Issues of Air Filtration for Your Museum” on Monday, November 23, 2020, from 3 to 4 pm.
